Sep 20: Kamakura Day trip

9:30 Kamakura Arrival

9:35 – 10:15 Komachi Street: street foods like dango, croquettes, or local sweets.

- Kamakura Naniwaya's Taiyaki
- Kamakura Chacha: best matcha sweets
- Kamakurakashi Kamakura Goro Main Store: Mochi sweets

10:30 - 11:30 Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine (16 min walk):

- Kamakura's most important Shinto shrine. Dedicated to Hachiman, the god of samurai and protector of the Minamoto clan.

12:00 - 1:00 Lunch at Hase area: (40min walk or 8 min taxi)

- streets lined with cafés and shops.
- Chikaramochiya: Traditional mochi place with soft red bean
- Teishokuya Shamoji: fresh shirasu-don (whitebait rice bowl)
- Woof Curry: popular Japanese Curry place

1:00 - Free time

2:00 - 3:30 Kōtoku-in Temple (Great Buddha) Must see!!! : (2 min walk).

- Amida Buddha standing about 13.35 meters tall
- Built in the 13th century (Visitors can step inside the hollow statue)

4:00 - 5:30 Yuigahama Beach & Seaside Café (16 min walk)

*20 min walk back to Kamakura St. or 4 min taxi

Sep 21: Travel to Matsumoto

10:20 Ikebukuro St. (Saikyō Line) * see Transportation PDF

- You can also buy Bento lunch at the train station before Azusa express!

1:45 Tabino Hotel (6min walk from Matsumoto St.)

<u>Drop off your luggage</u> before checking in to explore Matsumoto

- Lunch recommendation: (I would try to eat in the train since museum close early)
 - **Menshō Sakurō**: Popular ramen place (in Matsumoto St.)
 - Miyoda-Matsumoto: Famous Shinshu Soba (Nagano-style buckwheat noodles).

2:20 pm - 3:40 pm Matsumoto Castle (15 min walk or 5min taxi from hotel):

- You can get a taxi by asking the hotel front desk.
- **Free tour guide** at the castle but you can check with them in advance (https://www.npo-alsa.com/home-en)

4pm - 5 pm Matsumoto City Museum of Art : (close at 5pm)

- Modern art museum best known for works by Yayoi Kusama, a world-famous avant-garde artist born in Matsumoto (18 min walk or 7 min taxi)

*Dinner Recommendation:

- Botan-en: Japanese high-end BBQ place (famous Shinshu pork/Hida beef) Reservation
 - Standard course: 6,600 Yen
- **Suehiro**: Japanese Meat Cuisine (Reservation)
 - Dinner cost: around 15,000 Yen
- **Soba-dokoro Kippō**: soba made with buckwheat flour from Hakuba.
 - course : 3,000 Yen

*Other places to visit for light strolling around the town:

- Nakamachi Street: historic street in Matsumoto lined with traditional kura-style (white-walled storehouse) buildings, now home to cafés, craft shops, sake breweries, and galleries
- **Nawate Street:** famous for its <u>retro atmosphere</u>, frog-themed decorations, small shops, and local snacks. It's located along the river, near Matsumoto Castle.
- **Daio Wasabi Farm**: This offers a truly local vibe and a unique Japanese experience! One of **Japan's largest wasabi farms**, located in Azumino, Nagano Prefecture. Visitors can stroll along scenic irrigation canals, enjoy wasabi-themed snacks and souvenirs, and learn about the cultivation of wasabi. (30 min taxi from Hotel)
